Angel Guardians' programs include **Community Connections** a day program where individuals participate in recreation and social activities to develop social skills and independence. The **Very Special People Club** (VSP) provides a safe environment for individuals to develop social relationships and respite for parents and guardians. The **Team Works Crew** program helps prepare individuals to find, apply for, and keep competitive and integrated opportunities. **Artworks** is a creative engagement program fostering inclusion through the arts. Individuals may receive a commission on the sale of their artwork. ArtWorks individuals may receive a commission on the sale of their work which is featured throughout the Omaha community. The **Hand Me-Ups Thrift Store** accepts gently used clothing and furniture for all ages. Profits from these donations help to fund and maintain the needs of the organization and its individuals.
